The date was August 13, 1979—forty years ago. The location was Fort McKean State Park.

We were having a lodge picnic. There were over 50 people in attendance with Walter Ongstad as president. A special meeting was called for this day as the lodge had a big decision to make.

Mel Berg had been doing some research and much discussion had been held—this was the day for a decision. The subject for discussion was a proposed park on 12th Street and Bismarck Avenue (now known as Bismarck Expressway). The area encompassed six and a half acres. A grant of \$50,000 from HUD with a matching grant of \$50,000 from the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation was available.

The responsibility of the lodge included the moral obligation to clean the park in the spring, paint and repair buildings as necessary and add equipment if we so desired. The Bismarck Park Board, as well as the citizens of the community lent their support to this project.

When the question was called, at this special meeting, the 50 people in attendance unanimously voted yes, and Sons of Norway by this first step of many helped make the dream of a park in south Bismarck a reality!

Mel Berg was named chairman of the S/N Park Committee, he selected Rasmus Karlgaard, Doris Hanson, Virgil Bolt and Audrey Solheim as members of the committee.

You are invited to come and enjoy the day in Manfred and help us celebrate our 125th Anniversary!






Attention All Readers!!
