# Highlights from the Past Year at Sverdrup

Every March 15<sup>th</sup> the American Fraternal Alliance Year End Report, Lodge Achievement Form and Family Lodge of the Year Rating Form are due. This provides an opportunity to review all the activities Sverdrup Lodge has undertaken in the previous year. A few highlights from 2022 include 55 Sons of Norway related projects such as a lutefisk dinner, lefse sales, monthly socials and business meetings, language classes, Syttende Mai, Midsummer and St. Olaf celebrations, and a Mystery Bus Trip. These and many more activities totaled 4,387 hours.
