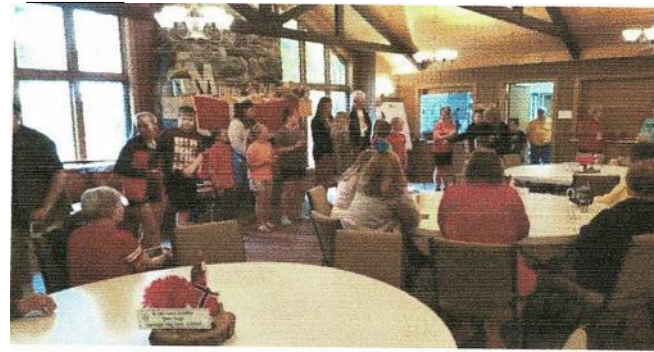

Who Can Attend?

- Sons of Norway District IV Members

- Children (ages 8-17) will be assigned to & housed with a boys or girls camp counselor.

How do I register?

Due to limited capacity, applications and payments are due by **May 15, 2024**. Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. A \$25 nonrefundable fee may be charged for all cancellations after this day and before June 1. There will be NO refunds after June 1. How much does it cost?

- \$200 for campers, ages 8-17
- \$250 for campers 18 and older
- Fees include instructional materials, meals and accommodations (except RV campers - \$20/night additional fee)
- Actual costs for camp are subsidized by donations from Sons of Norway lodges and District IV. Contact your lodge for individual scholarships too.
- For campers 8-17 years old, Youth Draxton Scholarship funds will be divided and reimbursed for those campers whose lodges did not pay the entire campership.
- A butikk is available for purchase of Norwegian candy, gift items and t-shirts. Bring spending money for the butikk.

What will I eat? Where will I sleep? The Metigoshe Ministries kitchen staff and Trollfjorden staff work together to provide delicious Norwegian foods that you will find to be a real treat.

Campers take turns assisting with meal clean-up and washing dishes, helping to keep camp prices down.

Supper will be served on Thursday and meals will be provided through brunch on Sunday.

Bunk beds are provided for youth campers. They should provide their own bedding and pillow. Let us know if you have someone you want to bunk near.

Bedrooms are available for adult campers. Bedding is provided for you.

What will I do there?

- Norwegian classes (required)
- Guided instruction in a variety of cultural skills will be offered, including cooking, rosemaling, wood crafts, and textile arts.*
- The youngest campers are offered small group instruction in age-appropriate crafts.

*Note: Participation in some of the activities will be by sign up and class numbers may be limited. You will need to make some choices because it will not be possible to participate in all classes. Try a different one each year!
