THE BOE STABBUR

Sverdrup Lodge of Sons of Norway accepted the gift offer of the stabbur which had been on their property for several years. 'John and Karen Boe purchased the stabbur from builder Bruce Meland in 1993. They met Mr. Meland at the Høstfest in



Minot and placed an order with him to make a stabbur to specific dimensions. It was built in Bend, Oregon, entirely out of cedar logs, placed on a flatbed trailer and pulled to North Dakota. It was placed in their backyard and they enjoyed having this special building on their property.

In October 2001, the Boes moved to Hamilton, Montana. The Boes realized they could not move the stabbur with them, and having connections with members of the lodge, asked if the lodge would like to have the stabbur for our Sons of Norway Park. Lodge members were very receptive to the idea and several of the members took on the project of moving the building. The Boe Stabbur is 11 feet by 12 feet. President LeRoy Nayes applied to the Sons of Norway Foundation for a grant to set the building on permanent pillars and to landscape that portion of the park. It was moved on January 5 and dedicated in May in honor of John and Karen Boe. It has graced our park now for 23 years.

It is time to replace the shingles on the small stabbur at the Sons of Norway Park. A few volunteers are needed to tackle the roof repair that is scheduled for Saturday, Sept. 14, 10:00 am; a rain back-up date is Sept.18th.
